

## **Scriptures for Week 2**

Prov 3:5-8 (AMP) Trust in *and* rely confidently on the Lord with all your heart And do not rely on your own insight *or* understanding. <sup>6</sup>In all your ways know *and* acknowledge *and* recognize Him, And He will make your paths straight *and* smooth [removing obstacles that block your way].

<sup>7</sup>Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the Lord [with reverent awe and obedience] and turn [entirely] away from evil. <sup>8</sup>It will be health to your body [your marrow, your nerves, your sinews, your muscles—all your inner parts] And refreshment (physical well-being) to your bones.

Psa 23 (ESV) The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. <sup>2</sup>He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. <sup>3</sup>He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. <sup>4</sup>Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. <sup>5</sup>You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. <sup>6</sup>Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

Isa 41:10 (HCSB) Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you; I will help you; I will hold on to you with My righteous right hand.

John 14:6 (AMP) <sup>6</sup>Jesus said to him, “I am the [only] Way [to God] and the [real] Truth and the [real] Life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

Acts 4:12 (ESV) And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.”

### **Jesus as Lord and Savior**

John 3:16-18 (HCSB) <sup>16</sup>“For God loved the world in this way: He gave His One and Only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him will not perish but have eternal life. <sup>17</sup>For God did not send His Son into the world that He might condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through Him. <sup>18</sup>Anyone who believes in Him is not condemned, but anyone who does not believe is already condemned, because he has not believed in the name of the One and Only Son of God.

Rom 3:9-10 (AMP) <sup>9</sup>Well then, are we [Jews] better off than they? Not at all; for we have already charged that both Jews and Greeks (Gentiles) are under the control of sin *and* subject to its power. <sup>10</sup>As it is written *and* forever remains written, “There is none righteous [none that meets God’s standard], not even one.

Rom 3:23 (ESV) for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Rom 5:8 (HCSB) But God proves His own love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us!

Rom 10:9 (ESV) because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

John 3:5-7 (HCSB) Jesus answered, “I assure you: Unless someone is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. <sup>6</sup>Whatever is born of the flesh is flesh, and whatever is born of the Spirit is spirit. <sup>7</sup>Do not be amazed that I told you that you must be born again.

Acts 4:12 (ESV) And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.”

### **Rescue Mission**

John 3:3 (ESV) Jesus answered him, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God.”

Col 1:13 (AMP) For He has rescued us ( YLT: who did rescue us out of the authority of the darkness) *and* has drawn us to Himself from the dominion of darkness, and has transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,

Acts 10:38 (ESV) how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

Zeph 3:15-19 (ESV) The Lord has taken away the judgments against you; he has cleared away your enemies. The King of Israel, the Lord, is in your midst; you shall never again fear evil.<sup>16</sup> On that day it shall be said to Jerusalem: “Fear not, O Zion; let not your hands grow weak.<sup>17</sup> The Lord your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; he will rejoice over you with gladness; he will quiet you by his love; he will exult over you with loud singing.

<sup>18</sup> I will gather those of you who mourn for the festival, so that you will no longer suffer reproach.

<sup>19</sup> Behold, at that time I will deal with all your oppressors. And I will save the lame and gather the outcast, and I will change their shame into praise and renown in all the earth.

### **Plan A**

Gen 1:26 (ESV) Then God said, “Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.”

Col 3:4 (ESV) When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.

1 John 1:9 (ESV) If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Eph 2:4-10 (HCSB) But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love that He had for us, <sup>5</sup> made us alive with the Messiah even though we were dead in trespasses. You are saved by grace! <sup>6</sup> Together with Christ Jesus He also raised us up and seated us in the heavens, <sup>7</sup> so that in the coming ages He might display the immeasurable riches of His grace through His kindness to us in Christ Jesus.

<sup>8</sup> For you are saved by grace through faith, and this is not from yourselves; it is God’s gift— <sup>9</sup> not from works, so that no one can boast. <sup>10</sup> For we are His creation, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared ahead of time so that we should walk in them.
